1. We are back in Cambodia.

2. Guidance for the whole family as we will be separated in 3 locations..
 - a. I and my wife in Cambodia to continue the “work” here
 - b. Our first son, Hezron, will be staying in Baguio City to pursue his college education. He is now in 2nd year taking Mechatronics Engineering
 - c. Heijz, our second son and Heidzn, our youngest daughter will be staying in another province to finish their high school. Heijz is grade 10 and Heidzn is grade 7. They will be both staying with my sister in the northern part of the Philippines.
 - d. Provision for their schooling and monthly sustenance as well as provision for our stay in Cambodia.
3. Anointing, protection and wisdom as we visit churches to promote the mission work in Cambodia.

For the ministry in Cambodia

1. Provision for the ministry needs: workers and teachers financial support as they do their community work
2. Provision for our food packs distribution in the trash dumpsite in Battambang City. We are distributing food packs; 10 kilos of rice, 10 packs of instant noodles, 5 cans of sardines, hygiene kits, facemask and drinking water. We have around 100 families in the trash dumpsite
3. Guidance and vision among the community leaders; that they would continue to minister to their fellow countrymen manifested in their love, concern and changed lives.
4. Guidance and provision for our dormers at our dorm ministry. Presently, we have 16 young people studying in high school and in college.
5. Opportunities for our college graduates; we have 4 graduates this year, 3 accountancy and business administration graduates.
6. Provision and wisdom for our 4 Bible School students who are presently taking Certificate of Ministerial Studies.
