Day 04

CAMBODIA & THAILAND BORDER CONFLICT

Thailand and Cambodia, two Southeast Asian neighbours, are caught in a tense border conflict with deep historical and political roots. Disputed territory, national pride, and past colonial boundaries have sparked clashes, displacing hundreds of thousands and claiming lives on both sides. Though a ceasefire has been announced, mistrust remains, and the threat of further violence is real. The people of both nations, especially the vulnerable, bear the greatest burden. In the midst of tension, the Church is called to stand in the gap for healing, justice, and peace.

Pray for Spirit-led reconciliation, for peace to be planted where pride and pain have taken root, and for protection over all civilians.

Pray for opportunities humanitarian help to open doors for the Gospel/Discipleship among Thai and Cambodians.

Pray for the Body of Christ in both nations to rise in bold, Spirit-filled intercession, to bring the Kingdom of God near in word, love & power and to be agents of lasting transformation.

PRAYER FOCUS: KYRGYZSTAN

Kyrgyzstan is a mountainous Central Asian nation of around 7 million people, historically shaped by nomadic traditions and Soviet influence. Islam is the dominant religion, often mixed with folk practices, while Christianity is a small minority. Most believers are from ethnic minorities, though a growing number of Kyrgyz people have come to faith, often at great personal cost. The government allows limited religious freedom but keeps strict control over religious groups, and evangelism among Muslims can lead to harassment or persecution.

Pray for Spirit-empowered revival, open hearts to the Gospel, bold witness among believers, and supernatural encounters that bring Kyrgyz people into the family of God.

Pray for the Church to walk in boldness, mature in discipleship, and multiply Spirit-filled communities grounded in the Word and power of God.
